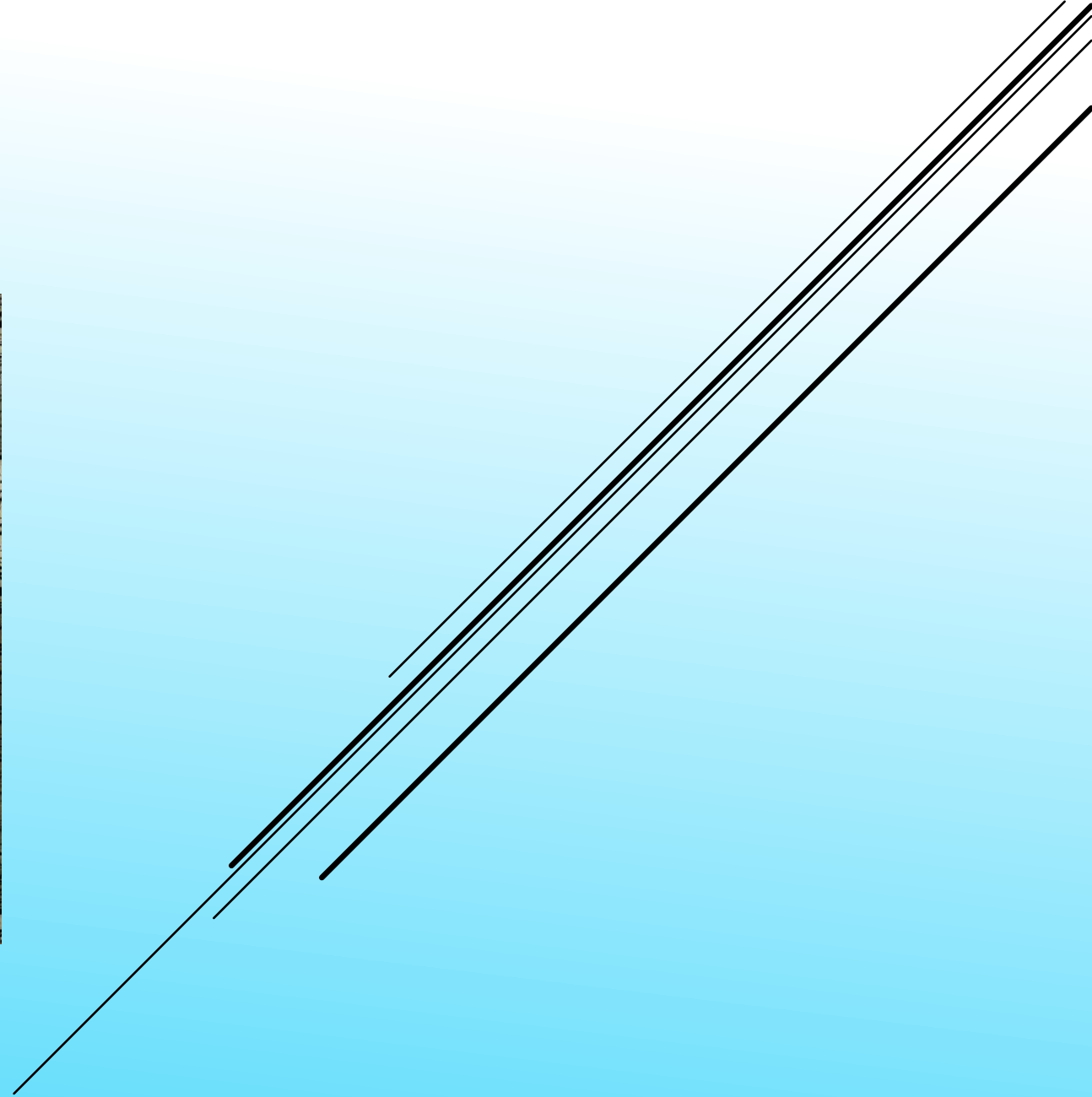

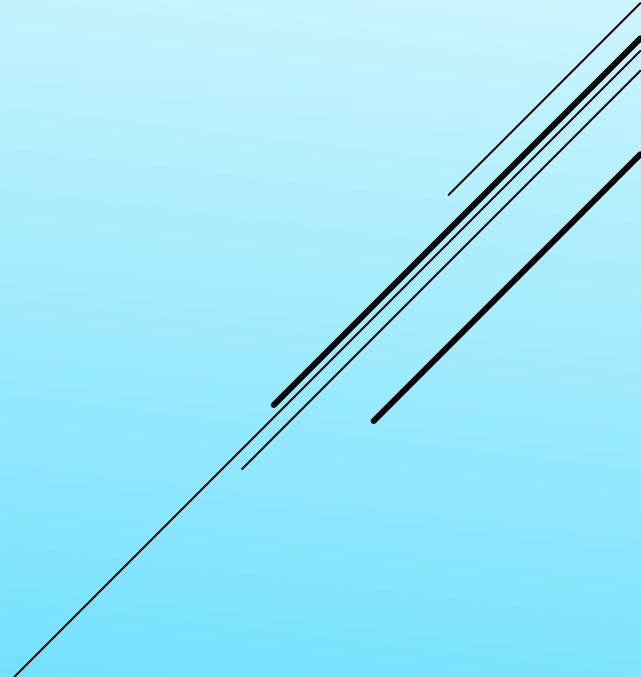

He spoke, it was done, and continues to stand fast;

They trust that from death He will rescue and save them,
And keep them all living when famine comes near.
The LORD we await is our help and protection,
Our heart is glad trusting in His holy Name.
O LORD, let Your covenant love be upon us,
As we hold to You and the hope that we claim.
